Key Truth: God takes the man whom He created (Adam) and puts him in the Garden of Eden to work and take care of it.

God then tells Adam that he is free to eat from any tree in the garden except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Finally God declares that it is not good for Adam to be alone and then brings to him all the animals and allows Adam to name them.
